

Fourth Business Award Win for TWMA

TWMA, the integrated environmental services specialist, has won its fourth award this year. The 'Enterprise 250 awards' recognises the achievements of mid-sized companies - TWMA beat off strong competition to win the award for innovation and design.

TWMA was praised for its technical achievements in taking the TCC-RotoMill thermal treatment plant offshore and its ability to process hydrocarbon contaminated drill cuttings in an environmentally sound way, on location - the success of the process has placed the company in a pre-eminent position in the increasingly important drill cuttings treatment sector of the business.

Ronnie Garrick, managing director, TWMA, said: "We are delighted to have won another award this year which highlights the continuing success of the business since the investment by Lime Rock in January. The environmental sector of the oil and gas industry is still relatively immature but it is certain that the services we provide will be required on a worldwide basis if the increasingly robust environmental standards set by both government and industry are to be met."

The judging panel commented: "TWMA is an absolute clear winner - it is very unusual to find a company which can lay claim to having the only worldwide capability in a particular market. This is a business we really want to celebrate."

The TCC-RotoMill is an integrated part of the range of environmental services provided by TWMA. These include the treatment of hydrocarbon contaminated wastes (drill cuttings), the handling and storage of these wastes, slops and sludge treatment, general waste management and engineering services.

TWMA won the Sir Ian Wood award for Innovation at the Grampian Business Awards this Year, Jimmy Cantlay, senior operations manager in Egypt was crowned 'Rising Star' at the Northern Star Business Awards and the company was also awarded a financial accolade from the 'Deal & Dealmakers' award for its MBO.

The 'Enterprise 250 awards' took place in Edinburgh last night [7th of November 2007].
